THE ST. MATTHEWS ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

typically awards scholarships on the fourth Sunday in July. However, we regret to report that scholarships will not be presented this year, due to the lack of applications. Endowment scholarships are available to all members who meet these qualifications:

- 1. Active member of St. Matthews UMC.
- 2. Currently participating in one or more church organizations.
- 3. Has proof of acceptance from a four-year college/university, community college, or licensed trade school.
- 4. An application submitted by the second Sunday in June.

There are also Legacy scholarships available for Endowment scholarship recipients who meet specified criteria. These scholarships are established by individual church members who want a scholarship in his/her name or a family member.

A contribution of five thousand dollars or more is required and then the donor sets his/her criteria. A percentage of the interest is awarded in the name of the donor as endowment recipients qualify. All funds are invested in the United Methodist Foundation of Western North Carolina Conference.
